

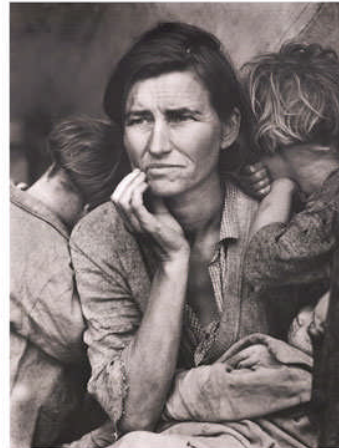
What you can do

(Proceeds from the stores are dedicated to helping families with other material assistance.)

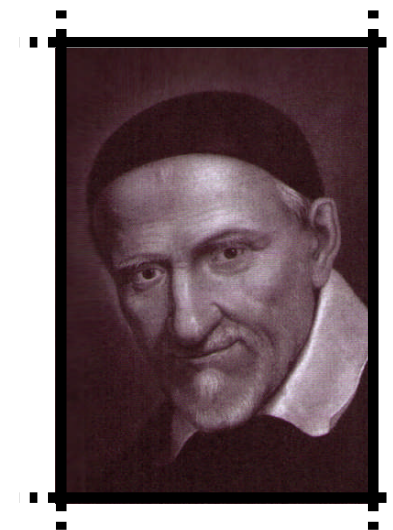
The Society of St. Vincent de Paul Social Services
