The council began their meeting in prayer.

- **Meeting Summary**

- Karin gave kudos for the Chris Stefanik Reboot event and Christmas Season-Advent/Christmas liturgies were great
- Dave reported the Reboot team will be meeting 1/11/18. He solicited comments from members about Reboot for him to take to the team. All comments brought out positive experiences. It was stated people were uplifted. Fr. Brad wondered if the last minute ticket sales and attendance was community personality. Dave believes it is. Bill reflected on the concept of Reboot that every morning is a new day, some people never “reboot” after a difficult experience. Seeing Jesus at church can make a person happy.
- Karin reflected, we have a vibrant community. Linda thinks it seems since Reboot our community is happy.
- Linda asked was anything being done to advertise Jaime Thietten. i.e. from the pulpit. Electronic bulletin board, information kiosk, poster in youth room, inclusion in the weekly email burst, contacting and sending PR to all deanery parishes as well as Pullman, and the bulletin are avenues being utilized.
- Announcements at the beginning of Mass have been received well overall.
- Fr. Brad enjoys interacting with the kids a bit but still finds he has a lot of names of parishioners to learn.
- Dave played a brief clip of Fr Ricardo of True Magnificence presenting the concept of the liturgy of sports.
- Focus tool highlights discipleship as a road map - Where am I, and where do I want be?
The term disciple may be a bit formal. Thinking of discipleship in terms of a seed, there are two aims of a seed; 1. To be rooted 2. To flower into disciples. Rooting vs. Growing
- Family faith formation bringing to the forefront a stirring within both the children and parents.
- Challenge with timing on growing discipleship
- Shannon desires to focus on fostering the development of friendship groups. Some groups are in place now- it is a matter of how to move those into igniting discipleship. Having those kinds of discussions are not part of our culture. It's counter culture. To have the opportunity to connect with others if you don't already have someone to grow in discipleship with. Seems reboot is taking seed. Just takes some time.
- The more mixing we have of Mass attendees is good for making/expanding friend base.
