INSTRUCTIONS

Dear High School Graduating Senior:

The Knights of Columbus Council 1024 will award one \$2000.00 scholarship annually to one graduating high school seniors from All Saints Parish based upon scholarship application requirements and the results of a selection committee, the application requirements are as follows:

- ❖ Must be a current High School senior and be a Catholic in good standing* with All Saints Catholic Church that plans to attend an institution of higher education in the fall of their High School graduation year.
- ❖ A High School GPA (Grade Point Average) of 2.5 (on 4-point scale) or better.

Your application packet must contain:

- ❖ An application form.
- ❖ A copy of SAT or ACT scores or similar college entrance examination, if available.
- ❖ A copy of Academic Transcript.
- ❖ Scholarship Recommendation Form in sealed envelope from school
- ❖ An essay (approximately 500 words,) that
 - Describes your educational objectives and goals, and
 - Describes and elaborates on how your Catholic faith has been part of your personal and academic life.
 - **DO NOT** PUT YOUR NAME OR ADDRESS ON THE ESSAY!
- ❖ Additional references, recommendations, and information on other awards.

The Knights of Columbus Treasurer will disburse the scholarship money directly to the administrative bursar of the recipient's choice of higher education beginning the second semester of the recipient's freshman year.

It is the intent to ensure that the scholarship award money be made available to the scholarship award recipient to assist in the costs associated with higher education. In the event the recipient elects not to attend an institution of higher education in the fall of his/her high school graduation year or discontinues higher education after the first semester of the freshman year, the scholarship awards money is forfeited back to the Knights of Columbus Council 1024 Lewiston, Idaho. In the event the scholarship award recipient is included on a waiting list to attend an institution of higher education, the award money will be reserved for the scholarship award recipient for a period of up to, but not exceeding two years following the date of the scholarship award. The recipient must be enrolled in a minimum two-year program.

It is the responsibility of the recipient to validate their attendance during the second semester of the recipient's freshman year at the institution. This validation needs to take place with the Grand Knight, Treasurer, or Financial Secretary of the Knights of Columbus Council 1024 of Lewiston, Idaho.

Winner of the scholarship grant will be announced in May.

*Good standing referrers to someone who:

1. Attends Mass on Sundays and Holy days of obligation.
2. Confesses sins at least once a year.
3. Receives the Eucharist at least during the Easter season.
4. Observes the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence.
5. Provides for the needs of the Church according to their own ability.
